1. The Prophecy of Simeon : (St. Luke; Chapter 2, Verses 34-35)
2. The flight into Egypt : (St. Matthew; Chapter 2, Verses 13-14)
3. The loss of the Child Jesus in the temple : (St. Luke; Chapter 2, Verses 43-45)
4. The meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross : (St. Luke; Chapter 23, Verse 27)
5. The Crucifixion : (St. John; Chapter 19, Verses 25-27)
6. The taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross : (St. Mark; Chapter 15, Verses 43-46)
7. The burial of Jesus : (St. John; Chapter 19, Verses 41-42)
